



# ***Sport Climbing Queensland State Youth Team Selection Policy 2019***

## **1. Foreword**

This document outlines the Guidelines for the selection of the Queensland Youth Team to compete at the Australian Youth Nationals 2019. SCQ recognizes that this policy can always be improved and welcomes any feedback by its members. Applications can be sent in by completing the google form on the Sport Climbing Queensland Website.

## **2. Structure**

The number of positions available on the team is dictated by [SCA Selection Policy](#). Sport Climbing Queensland for 2019, under section 2.1.5 of the SCA National Youth Selection policy has been allocated 8 positions per discipline, per category, per gender. This translates to the following for each discipline of Lead, Boulder, and Speed:

## **3. Purpose**

This policy aims to define a fair and transparent process by which the Queensland Youth team will be selected. Allowing the selection of the team to be done in a logical, fair and unbiased manner.

The SCQ Board will ensure qualifying athletes are informed of, and follow, the process for selection. This will be done by sending personal emails to all members, Social Media Announcements and SCQ Website Advertising.

This policy will be made available to all SCQ members.

SCA Selection Policy 2019 dictates that the top 3 in their state ranking shall be automatically selected on the team (See 2.2.1 of [SCA Selection Policy](#)), the remaining

spots in the quota shall be filled at the discretion of the state body (Section 2.2.2 of [SCA Selection Policy](#))

Note: *This selection relates only to the competitors in Lead and Boulder Disciplines. There is no selection criteria for Speed.*

## 4. Youth Team Selection Process

The selection process for the remaining positions consists of three stages:

- Ranking of all applications based solely off their results as outlined in Section 4.2.
- Consideration of factors other than results as outlined in Section 4.3.
- Acceptance of the team as a whole as outlined in Section 4.4.

Any board members who are also an applicant or conflict of interest must excuse themselves from the discussions and process of selection for the Category for which there is a conflict. They do not receive a vote for their category. Such members are allowed to partake in the selection of the team for categories for which they are not an applicant or conflict of interest.

### 4.1. Automatic Selection on Team

Applications that are in the top 3 positions for that discipline (Lead or Boulder) from the “Results Ranking” stage (Section 5.2) are guaranteed a place on the team should they wish to compete.

### 4.2. Team Selection for Lead

The Top 3 podium winners from the 2019 QLD Lead Titles are automatically selected for the team under the [SCA Selection Policy Section 2.2.1](#). Automatic selection on the team can be removed from an applicant in the case that the applicant is under disciplinary action by SCA or SCQ.

The remaining 5 positions are given preference to the top 8 finalists of the 2019 QLD Lead Title in that category. Should the team not be filled by the cutoff date specified by SCQ then the remaining spots will be filled by Special Considerations applicants as listed in 4.5.

### 4.3. Team Selection for Boulder

The Top 3 podium winners from the 2018 QLD Boulder Titles are automatically selected for the team under the [SCA Selection Policy Section 2.2.1](#). The top three podium winners staying in the same category will be given a position, followed by the top three moving up a category. This leaves room for two wild cards. Automatic selection on the team can be removed from an applicant in the case that the applicant is under disciplinary action by SCA or SCQ.

The remaining positions are given preference to other finalists of the 2018 QLD Boulder Titles in that category based on ranking in section 4.4. Should the team not be filled by the cutoff date specified by SCQ then the remaining spots will be filled by Special Considerations applicants as listed in 4.5.

### 4.4. Results Ranking Stage

Applications will be ranked strictly according to and in the order of the criteria outlined below.

1. Most Recent National Rankings (Top 10)
2. Most Recent Qld State Titles results (Top 24).

Any persons who are unranked from the above criteria shall be ranked using their age category results as outline below:

1. Most Recent Age Category National Rankings (Top 10)
2. Most Recent Age Category Qld State Titles results (Top 24).

Older category results shall be ranked above younger age categories. That is to say Junior results shall be ranked above Youth A results, Youth A results shall be ranked above Youth B results, and so on.

Any person not ranked by the above criteria shall be ranked by the date in which their application was received by SCQ.

### 4.5. Consideration Stage

The selection of a team must take into account factors beyond previous results. These may include but are not limited to:

- Inability to compete at recent events.
- Athlete behaviour and conduct at previous events and within the community.
- Commitment to the sport.
- Recent results in social competitions.



To accommodate these the team selection will go through a second stage after the initial ranking of applicants. Once all applications have been ranked, board members will review all unsuccessful applications. A board member can propose that an application that did not make the cut-off deserves a place on the team.

The proposal must consist of both the applicant to be provided a place on the team and the applicant who's place will be taken, and justification as to why they deserve a place on the team. The person who is removed from the 'proposed team' cannot be one of the top three 'ranked' applicants from stage one. For the proposal to be successful 75% or more of the board must vote in favour.

## 4.6. Sign off Stage

Once all considerations have been put forward and voted on, the board will vote on accepting the team. The vote may be on the team as a whole or split by category and/or gender. For the vote to be successful 75% or more of the board must vote in favour of accepting the team.

In the case that the board cannot come to agreement, the board will be asked to cast their vote again and the president and vice-presidents votes shall count for double. This vote will take place at the next board meeting.

Should the team not be accepted once the board votes are recast with the extra weighted votes, then stage two will be repeated with a quorum board present to vote and the disputed part of the team voted upon again. If by the end of the meeting a team is not accepted by vote as outlined above, the disputed part of the team will default to the 'ranked' team from stage one.

## 4.7. Timeline and Commitments

Applications are due before Midnight on Sunday 24th of March 2019. The Queensland team will be announced, and athletes made aware, on the 27th of March 2019. All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application.

# 5. Appeals

Appeals should be emailed to [info@sportclimbingqueensland.com](mailto:info@sportclimbingqueensland.com) before Midnight on Friday 29th of March 2019. Appeals will be considered and voted on by the SCQ board and replied to within 3 days of the team announcement. An appeal requires a 75% majority vote to be successful.

They are permitted to confirm by an applicant whether or not their application has been received. Once application have closed the information contained within an application will be available to the SCQ board. This information is confidential and shall not be shared with anyone not on the SCQ board.
